REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS Grades 1-8:

- Complete Student Registration Form.
- Provide copies of child's birth and baptismal certificates.
- Provide copies of child's yearly report cards including present school year's report card, plus yearly standardized test scores (if applicable).
- Copy of Blue Florida Certificate of Immunization (Form 680) and Gold School Entry Health Exam (Form 3040).
- Pay registration fee once child has been accepted.
- Proof of primary residential responsibility if student does not live with both parents (legal court document).
- **Catholic families** are registered members of a local parish who attend Mass on a regular basis, financially support the parish using church envelopes, and participate in the life of the parish.

ADDITIONAL FOR TRANSFERRING STUDENTS WITHIN
THE STATE OF FLORIDA and OUT-OF-STATE STUDENTS
(Pre-K 4 through Grade 8):

- If family is Catholic, please ask the pastor of your present parish for a letter of recommendation.
- If children are presently in a Catholic school, please ask your school principal for a family recommendation.
- Once your child has been accepted, proof is required of the following:
(1) Blue Florida Certificate of Immunization (Form 680) - Florida Statute 232.032 requires a Florida Certificate of Immunization of

all new students before entering school. These certificates may be obtained from a private doctor or the Lee County Health Department (332-9601). These records may be obtained from your previous school (within the State of Florida).

(2) Gold School Entry Health Exam (Form 3040) - Florida Statute 232.0315 requires a school entry health examination upon initial entrance to a Florida school completed within one (1) year prior to enrollment. These records may be obtained from your previous school (within the State of Florida).

Students in Grades Pre-K through Grade 8 who are making their initial entry into a Florida school from another state must present a record of a physical examination completed within the past 12 months. A Florida school entry form 3040 is preferred. For students transferring to a Florida school a comparable form from another state would be acceptable if completed within 1 year of enrollment.

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS FOR PRE-K 3, Pre-K 4 (VPK) and KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS:

- Pre-K 3 - child must be 3 years of age on or before September 1.
- Pre-K 4 (VPK) - child must be 4 years of age on or before September 1.
- Kindergarten - child must be 5 years of age on or before September 1.
- For all Pre-K 3, Pre-K 4 and Kindergarten children:
- Complete Student Registration Form.
- Provide copies of your child's birth and baptismal certificates.
- Blue Florida Certificate of Immunization (Form 680) - Florida Statute 232.032 requires a Florida Certificate of Immunization of all new students before a child can enter school.
- Gold School Entry Health Exam (Form 3040) - Florida Statutes 232.0315 requires a school entry health examination upon initial entrance to a Florida school completed within one (1) year prior to enrollment.
- Pay registration fee once child has been accepted.

- Proof of primary residential responsibility if student does not live with both parents (legal court document).
- **Parish-affiliated Catholic families** are registered members of a local parish who attend Mass and use the weekly church offering envelopes.

ADDITIONAL IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR 2009-2010:

- All students in Preschool and Grades 1 thru 8 are required to have varicella vaccine or a history of chicken pox documented by a health care provider.
- All students in Kindergarten and Grade 1 are required to have 2 doses of varicella vaccine or proof of chicken pox disease.
- All students in Kindergarten through Grade 12 are required to have two doses of measles, mumps and rubella (preferably as MMR vaccine).
- All students in Grades 7 through 12 are required to have a tetanus-diphtheria booster Td within the last 5 years. Beginning with the 2009-2010 school year, documentation of a tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis-containing vaccine (Tdap) will be required for students entering/attending 7th grade instead of Td.

- Kindergarten through Grade 8 - \$5,250

- Voluntary Pre-K 4 (VPK)*
 - 5 full days/week \$5,250
 - 5 days/AM only \$2,625

- Pre-K 3
 - 5 full days/week \$5,250
 - 3 full days/week \$3,150
 - 5 days/AM only \$2,625
 - 3 days/AM only \$1,575

Non-Catholic families or Non-Affiliated Catholic families:

- Kindergarten through Grade 8 - \$6,200

- Voluntary Pre-K 4 (VPK)*
 - 5 full days/week \$6,200
 - 5 days/AM only \$3,100

- Pre-K 3
 - 5 full days/week \$6,200
 - 3 full days/week \$3,720
 - 5 days/AM only \$3,100
 - 3 days/AM only \$1,860

*If Florida Voluntary Pre-K vouchers are granted, that amount will be subtracted from the total amount owed. The child must be 4 years of age, but not yet 5, on or before September 1, 2009, to qualify for the voucher.
